Dream events are imaginary, but they are related to real experiences in the dreamer's life and seem real to the dreamer while they are occurring. Some dreams are pleasant, others are annoying, and some are even frightening (nightmares). A person might only vaguely recall some dreams while vividly remembering others. No one recalls every dream, and in general, dreams are easily forgotten. In most dreams, the dreamer can see, and in some, he may also be able to hear, smell, touch and taste. Most dreams occur in color, although a person might not recall the colors of objects in a dream. Dreams are influenced by factors in the dreamer's life and thoughts. Based on these influences, they may be placed into categories, such as prophetic, standard, physical and nightmare, **to name a few.**
